

BOOKING AGREEMENT

This **Booking Agreement** is made and executed this _____ day of January 2026, in the Municipality of Dinalupihan, Province of Bataan, Philippines, by and between:

FIRST PARTY

LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) OF DINALUPIHAN, BATAAN,

a local government unit duly organized and existing under Philippine laws, with office address at **San Ramon, Dinalupihan, Bataan**, represented herein by its Municipal Mayor, **HON. GERMAN M. SANTOS JR.**, hereinafter referred to as the "FIRST PARTY."

SECOND PARTY

TEAMBOL ENTERTAINMENT PRODUCTION,

a duly registered entertainment production company, with office address at **324 Road, Bagong Pag-asa, Quezon City**, represented herein by **Ms. Eliza Ignacio Timbol**, hereinafter referred to as the "SECOND PARTY."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY is organizing the **108th Dinalupihan Foundation Day** celebration;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY desires to engage the professional services of the SECOND PARTY for the booking and performance of musical artists for the said event;

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY has the authority and capability to provide the required talents and related services.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. EVENT DETAILS

- **Event Title:** 108th Dinalupihan Foundation Day
- **Date:** January 29, 2026
- **Venue:** Dinalupihan Field Oval, Kataasan, Dinalupihan, Bataan

2. ARTISTS / TALENTS

The SECOND PARTY shall provide the following artists:

- **Up Dharma Down- 45 minutes performances**
- **Dilaw- 45 minutes performances**
- **Lily-1 hour performances**

Each artist shall render a **forty-five (45) minutes except for Lily 1 hour live performance.**

3. TALENT FEE AND PAYMENT TERMS

The total **Talent Fee Package** shall be:

TWO MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS
(PHP 2,753,500.00)

Payment shall be made as follows, subject to government accounting and auditing rules:

- **Fifty percent (50%)** of the total talent fee shall be paid **prior to the event date**;
- **Fifty percent (50%)** of the total talent fee shall be paid **after the successful completion of the performances.**

4. OBLIGATIONS OF THE FIRST PARTY

The FIRST PARTY agrees to provide the following for the duration of the event:

1. Technical manpower and services necessary for the event;
2. Production staff to assist in the overall conduct of the program;
3. Adequate **stage security and event security** throughout the entire duration of the event;
4. An **air-conditioned room** for the artists and production team;
5. **Clean, private, and secured restroom facilities;**
6. Sufficient **tables and chairs** for artists and production staff;
7. **Meals and bottled drinking water** for the artists and authorized production personnel.

5. OBLIGATIONS OF THE SECOND PARTY

The SECOND PARTY agrees to:

1. Ensure that all artists arrive at the venue at least **one (1) hour before their scheduled performance;**
2. Ensure the professional conduct and performance of the artists;
3. Facilitate a **photo opportunity** involving the artists, **LGU officials**, and **selected viewers**, subject to reasonable time and security considerations;
4. Coordinate closely with the FIRST PARTY regarding schedules, technical requirements, and event flow.

6. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be held liable for failure or delay in the performance of its obligations due to events beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to natural calamities, government restrictions, or similar force majeure events.

RE-SCHEDULING OF PERFORMANCE

7. Re-scheduling Due to Typhoon or Heavy Rain

In the event that the performance is affected by typhoon, heavy rain, or severe weather conditions, the FIRST PARTY shall inform the SECOND PARTY at least two (2) days prior to the scheduled event date that the event shall be re-scheduled.

In such case:

- The event shall be re-scheduled to a mutually agreed date; and
- No additional payment, penalty, or charges shall be required from the FIRST PARTY beyond the agreed talent fee.

7.1 Re-scheduling Due to Acts of God

In the event of Acts of God (including but not limited to natural disasters, government-imposed restrictions, or other unforeseen events beyond the control of both parties):

- a. The parties shall enter into good faith negotiations to re-schedule the event;

b. If the artists/bands are already present at the venue or have arrived in the locality at the time the event is cancelled or postponed, the FIRST PARTY shall pay only fifty percent (50%) of the total talent fee as compensation for the re-scheduling of the event;

c. The remaining balance, if any, shall be subject to the terms mutually agreed upon for the re-scheduled performance.

8. TERMINATION

This Agreement may be terminated by mutual written consent of both parties or due to material breach, subject to applicable laws, rules, and regulations.

9. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the **Republic of the Philippines**.


